Stage Adventures Club Workshops Breakdown

<p>Theatre games – is an introduction to the exciting world of theatre where our youngest actor are exposed to a variety of games and scenarios that will ask them to stretch their imagination.</p>
<p>Readers theatre – Is a form of theatre that allows the actor to have the script present at all times. It is a very low impact form of theatre. It's very inviting first time or nervous actors.</p>
<p>Musical Exploration – our clubbers will learn the basics of the Musical Theatre. They will strengthen their voices, their ability to act the song. Each class will feature different songs.</p>
<p>Story Theatre – Our youngest clubbers will reenact their favorite stories, the three little pigs, the ant and the grasshopper and many more. By the end of the class they will putting their own spin on these memorable stories. Each class will feature different stories.</p>
<p>Acting Basics – the basics of acting, how to develop a character. In this workshop students will breakdown acting to its fundamental elements.</p>
<p>Auditioning 101 – How to conquer those nerves, what are directors looking for?, how to put your best foot forward. How to prepare for the audition.</p>
<p>Stage Combat – How does acting happen when we are asked to include fights. Actors will learn basic hand to hand combat.</p>
<p>Broadway Dance – Not only will our students learn new dances each time, but the will also learn why choreographers make the choice they do. They would even get to put their stamp on the dances.</p>
<p>Acting for the Camera – this would be an introduction to the subtlety of acting for the camera. A chance to see the difference of acting on screen and on the stage.</p>
<p>Character Voices – exploration of all the different ways that we use our instruments to create different voice choices safely.</p>
<p>Stage Craft - In this class students would build a platform, a flat ,learn to apply scenic paint and light things theatrically</p>
<p>Costumes Design – what goes into creating a costume? What is the role of the costumer. They will walk away with the basic knowledge of sewing and costume construction.</p>
<p>Make-up – a crash course in the application and the reasoning behind theatrical make-up. Exploring corrective, old age, fantastical, and gore.</p>
