Course Descriptions
Theatre Games —an introduction to the exciting world of theatre games and scenarios are used to stretch imagination.
Readers Theatre —a great first exposure to acting using scripts at all times.
Musical Exploration —strengthens voices and acting to song featuring a variety of songs.
Story Theatre —re-enacts favorite stories: 3 little pigs, the Ant and the Grasshopper and more. Each session features a different story.
Acting Basics —teaches fundamental of acting including character development.
Auditioning 101 — teaches preparation for an audition, putting your best foot forward and conquering nerves.
Stage Combat —teaches the basics of hand to hand combat on stage.
Broadway Dance —teaches different dances each session and why choreographers choose the steps.
Acting for the Camera —teaches tricks for the camera and shows you on screen and stage.
Character Voices —explores different voice sounds.
Stage Craft —teaches platform and flat construction, scenic painting and theatric lighting.
Costume Design —teaches basic sewing and costume construction.
Make Up —explores corrective, aging, fantasy and gore make up techniques.
